Installation, setting and modification of content



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1 Installation

1.1 Requirements

For the installation of our Shopware 6 "Word Cloud" app, at least the following system configurations are required:

- PHP 7.2 or higher
 - Shopware 6.3.0 or higher

1.2 Installation

There are two ways to install the plugin:

- *Adding via the Plugin Manager in the backend*
To do this, you must first connect the Plugin Manager to your Shopware account. After that, the plugins purchased for this domain are available to you. You can now add the plugin via "Load plugin".
- *Adding via SFTP*
Download the .zip file of the plugin from your Shopware account and unzip it on your PC / laptop. Then you have to start an SFTP client and copy the unzipped folder into the following directory of your Shopware installation:
SHOPWARE_ROOT_VERZEICHNIS/custom/plugins/

After both variants you still have to install the plugin. You can find the added plugin under "My Plugins" and can install it via the context button and then activate it.

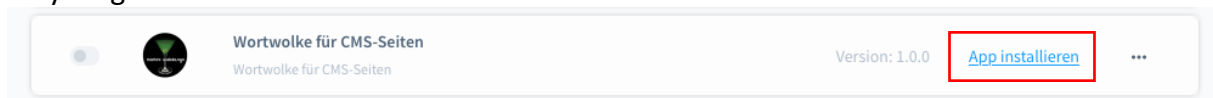


Figure 1 - Installing the plugin

2 Setting up the plugin

2.1 Adding to a world of experience (CMS page)

Open or create the Experience World page where you want to display the step-by-step price calculator.

Then open the block editor and select the tab "Martini Webdesign" from the "Block Category" drop-down menu. There you will find the block "Word Cloud". Drag and drop it into the desired page area.

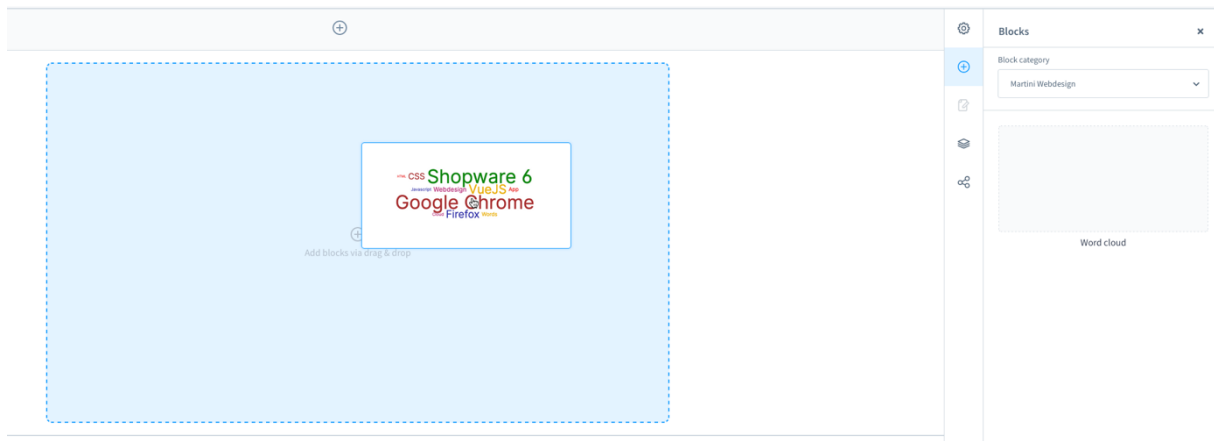


Figure 3: Integrating a block into the CMS page

Open Block Settings

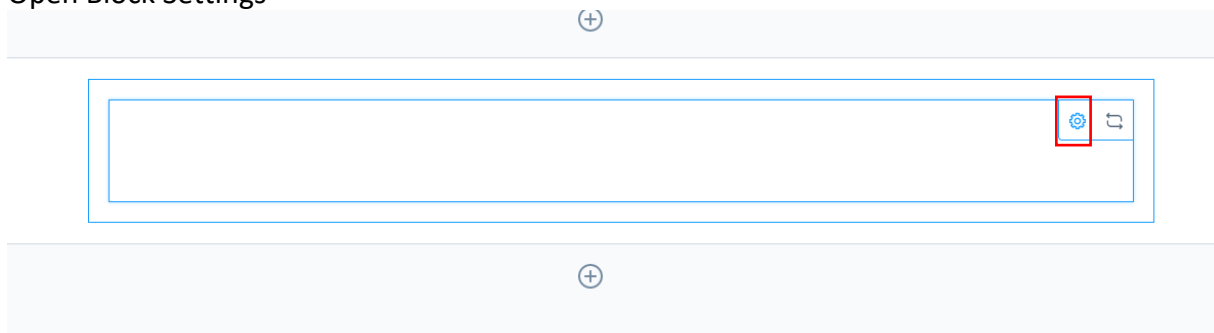


Figure 4 - Open Settings

2.3 General Settings

In the "General Settings" tab, you can set the following:

- Width of the word cloud
- How the words should be positioned in the word cloud
- Whether the words should be displayed in color
- If words are to be displayed in color, whether own colors should be taken per word or the colors should be assigned by the system
- Whether links in the words should be possible
- If links should be possible, whether they should be opened in a new tab

2.4 Word settings

In the Word Settings tab, the following values can be entered: (some are displayed dynamically depending on the "General Settings")

- Position
- Weight (determines the size of the word (1-10))
- Word
- Link
- Colour
